- 1. The above prescribed semester fees is for the Integrated First Degree (B.E. Computer Science) students admitted in the academic year 2025- 26 (For BITS-CSP 2+2 International Collaborative Programmes students at BITS Pilani only). For these students, the Semester Tuition, Summer Term and Hostel fees will be revised upward every year. The details of semester tuition fee and summer term fee is given below (unless the government announces any new levy/tax, which will be passed on to all existing students irrespective of their year of entry).
- 2. Summer Term Tuition Fee will be 35% of Semester Tuition Fee in corresponding Academic Year. All three Indian campuses of BITS Pilani will have the same summer term fee in an academic year. It is to be noted that every summer term is not part of the academic calendar except where specifically stated. Though the prescribed summer term fee is mentioned above, depending on the requirement of registration of a student in a given summer term, he/she will be required to pay summer term fee for that particular academic year only.
- 3. All fees are to be paid in advance. Only caution deposit and mess advance are refundable after adjustment of dues at the time of graduation or withdrawal from the Institute. This applies to prospective candidates who are seeking admission as well as ongoing students of the Institute.
- 4. Students will pay the BITS scheduled tuition and fees for the first two years. Once they are admitted into CSP, students will pay the CSP scheduled tuition and fees for nonresident (international) students.
- 5. The summary of the Tuition fees per semester & summer term tuition fee (as if applicable to register in summer term depending on the completion of course requirement of a given programme) for the students admitted in academic year 2025-26 [for BITS-CSP 2+2 International Collaborative Programmes students] is given below:

- # The BITS summer term fee will be charged either for the summer term of AY 2025-26 or the summer term of AY 2026-27 only depending on the completion of course requirement of a given programme.
- * EURO means official currency of France. CS Paris may adjust non-resident tuition and fees at the beginning of each academic year, which may typically increase between 1% and 2% per year. Information regarding other costs, such as amenities fees, mandatory health insurance, residence permit, and costs of living, can be found on the CS Paris programme guide.

Scholarships

BITS-CS Paris 2+2 International Collaborative Programmes' students are eligible for the Scholarship for components of the programme delivered at CentraleSupélec Paris, France. CS Paris Engineering Cohort Merit Scholarship levels are based upon successful engagement and academic performance in the first 2-year component of the programme at BITS Pilani. Students will be eligible for the CS Paris Engineering Cohort Merit Scholarships of up to € 12,000/year for 2 years based on successful engagement and academic performance in the first 2-year component of the programme at BITS. About 70% of students admitted to First Degree programmes under this 2+2 International Collaborative Programmes will get an annual scholarship in the range between 12,000 EURO to 3000 EURO as tabulated below:

As far as the initial two years of study at BITS Pilani campuses are concerned, students admitted to the 2+2 international collaborative programme with CentraleSupélec Paris are not eligible for a separate or specific scholarship category. However, they may compete with other BITS students of their batch for Merit and Merit-cum-Need (MCN) scholarships, based on their performance, alongside those admitted through BITSAT. These scholarships will be awarded as per the same eligibility criteria, and merit lists applicable to BITSAT-admitted students. It is important to note that the tuition fee waiver for such students will be capped at the same levels as those granted to students in the regular 4-/5-year programmes at the Indian campuses. For the final two years at CentraleSupélec Paris, students may avail scholarship opportunities as outlined above, subject to the scholarship policies of CentraleSupélec applicable to this cohort.
